### Sam Minutes

June 7, 2012

The June meeting of the Salinas Area Modelers was called to order by President Chris Meharg at 7:00 P. M. The meeting was held at the Landing Zone Restaurant in the Salinas Municipal Airport Terminal.

Board members present were Chris Meharg, Walt McCommons, Dennis Stanley, Pat O'Keefe, and Bob Mcgregor. Club members present were John Midgorden, Bill Range, Don Meeks, Malcolm Bruce, Bill Hurst, Ed Gylnn, Merle O'Grady, Dan and Alice Nolan and Dick Moeller.

Treasurer Bob McGregor gave a report of the finances in the Club's checking and savings accounts. He also shared that the club membership is now 87.

#### **Old Business**

1. Use Permit: Bob McGregor has had phone conversations with most of the county agencies who have to sign off on the Club's Use Permit. However, they can't do anything until they have received the application. Bob is in the process of drawing a new site plan that will include all the changes since the last site plan the County has on file. He is in the process of making the necessary measurements and taking photographs for the application package. It will be another couple of months before anything will be concluded.

Ed Glynn suggested that the latitude and Longitude numbers on the bulletin board are faded and need to be replaced.

- 2. Fun Fly: Dennis Stanley and Pat O'Keefe are running the Fun Fly event and shared with the members present the planned events. One event will be a bomb drop. Dennis showed the bomb and drop mechanism that will be strapped to the bottom of each air-plane. It will be a team event with a pilot and bombardier. Another event will be aTouch and Go plus dead stick landing (at idle). These two kinds of event will be run simultane-ously to speed up the process. A 40 size model or bigger, gas or electric, is recom-mended. There will be an entry fee of \$10. The Fun Fly event winner will get half the pot and the club the other half. This event will be held at the June Ruddergate on Saturday June 30th. It will begin at 9 A.M. Special announcements will be emailed to club mem-bers with the information and rules.
- 3. Ruddergate—June 30th: Dick Moeller has volunteered to cook at the June Ruddergate and he will be cooking chicken. Club members are encouraged to bring something for meal to compliment the chicken entrée. President Meharg emphasized the need for sign-ups for cooking at the remaining Ruddergates of the season. No cook, no Ruddergate. A sign up sheet is on the bulletin board at the field.

#### **New Business**

- 1. T-34 Races —August 11th: Dennis Stanley is listed as the official CD of this race, but Kevin Norris will be running the race. SAM will need to supply lap counters for the pilots and provide a lunch. SAM will supply the fuel and get all the entry fees.
- 2. Workday—June 16th: The projects for the coming workday will include cutting down the bamboo along the fence, mowing, spraying the weeds and cleaning up the overrun ar-eas at both ends of the runway. The field will be closed to flying until work is done and all Club members who come to work will be provided lunch.
